Registration & Fees

All participating schools must send a \$40, nonrefundable school registration fee when they register for the conference. Registration is due by February 1st, 2011. In addition, there is a \$20 per delegate charge. Those delegates attending independent of a school group are required to pay a \$25 delegate fee but do not have to pay a separate registration fee. Delegate fees are due by March 12th. GSMUN will provide all conference materials for all students and sponsors, as well as a snack Friday night and breakfast and lunch on Saturday.
